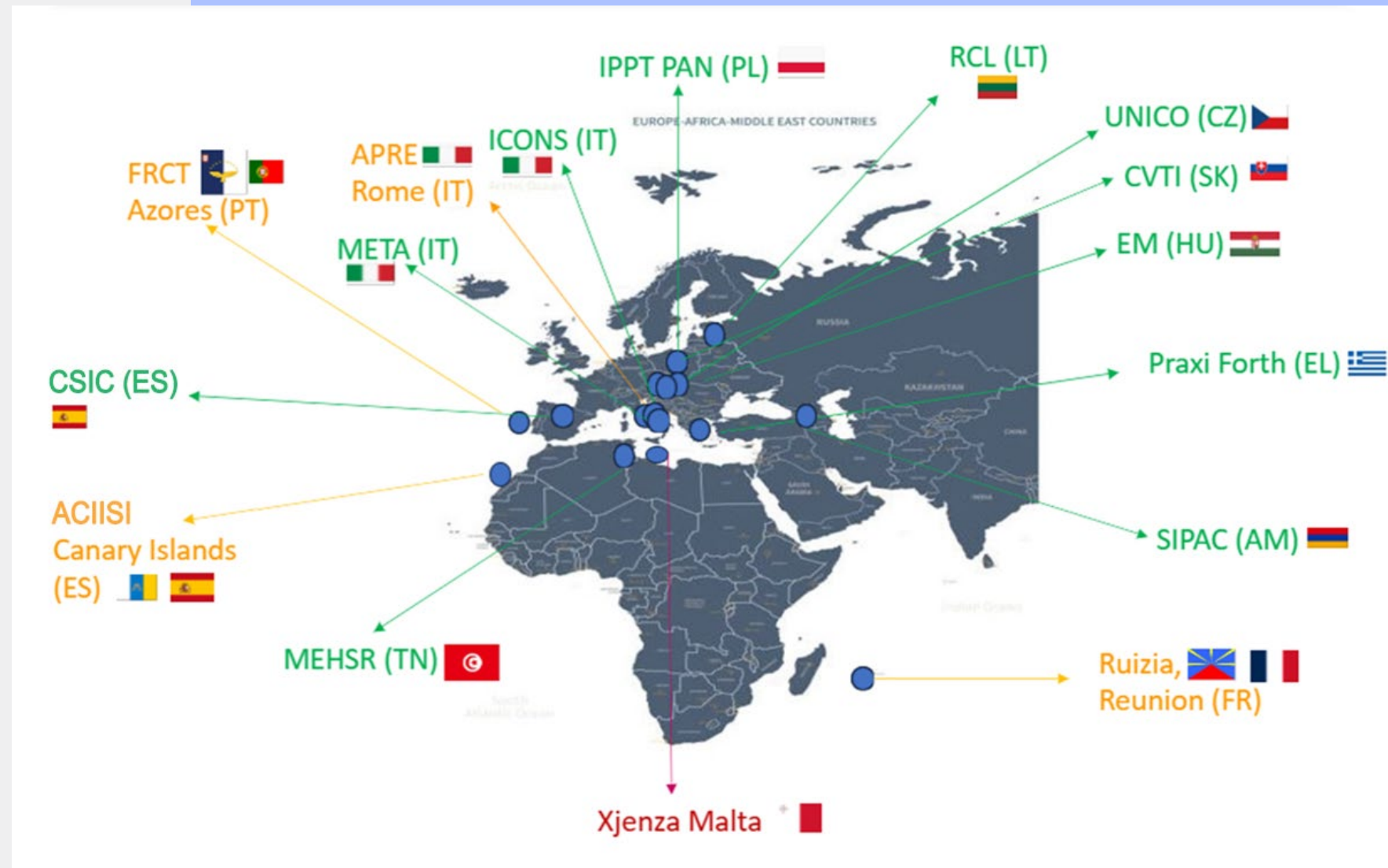
Main objective

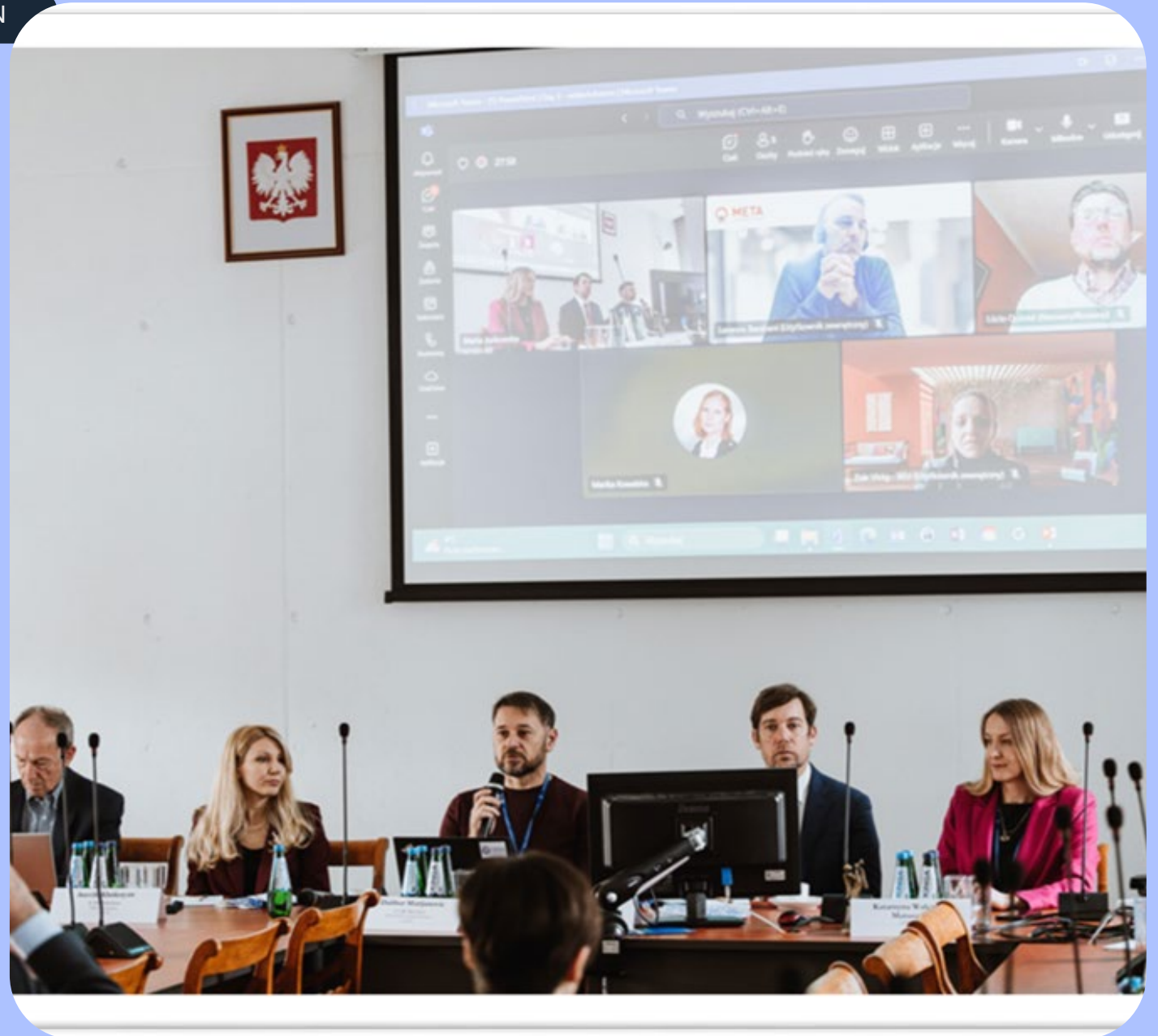

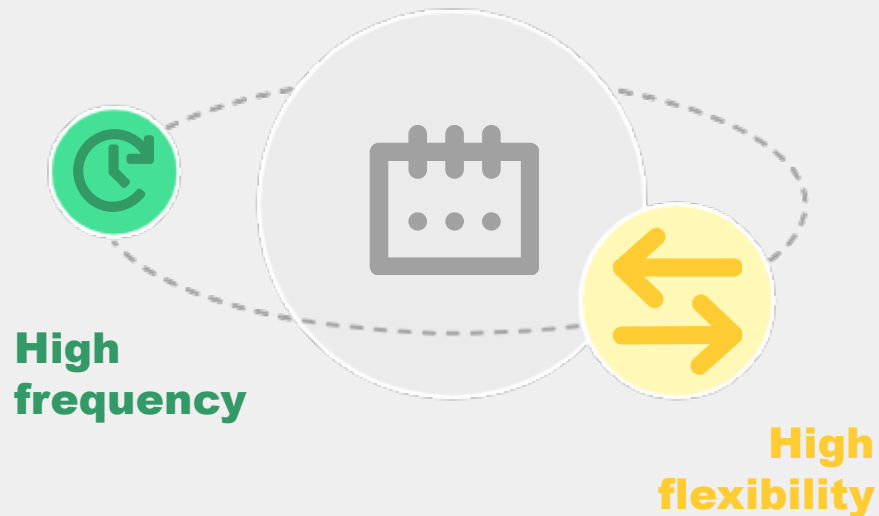

- Through a unique **Open Call** officially launched on **28 May 2025** and available until September 2028.
- Applications submitted at any time through an **on-line application** form in the Facility's website.
- Applications collected and assessed at pre-defined **cut-off dates** (every 3 months) to allocate the different services to the eligible organisations.
- Each organisation can present **multiple KERs, RTs and RMAs**.
